From our Safety Officer Alan Foley

Low Flying Aircraft.

Following up on this issue I have spoken at length to the CFI at Peninsula Aero Club about the problem we have with low-flying aircraft. He is familiar with our activities at P&DARCS but believes that most GA pilots would not know they are overflying a model aircraft field, despite our runways, buildings and wind socks. So we have to make them aware.

It is worth noting that GA aircraft have clearance to descend to 500 ft.

However, if an instructor is on board, then they can descend to 200 ft. for practiced forced landings.

We are seeing more of these incidents due to building development to the west of us where they would normally practice these manouvres. GA aircraft have a 'Fly Neighborly' clause which encourages pilots to stay clear of built-up areas when low flying.

The Committee is continuing to pursue this matter. In the meantime you are reminded to stay away from full size aircraft as safely as you can.

Field Managers Report - August 2016. By Norm Morrish

Hi guys, well final settlement for Dads house occurred on 15th August. It took me 5 days to do the final cleanout. The biggest job was he had collected compost for 61 years, resulting in very high garden beds. Final inspection by the agent requested the sharp sheet metal garden edges be removed for safety. Problem was the soil needed to be removed so 3 large trailer loads of hand shoveling and it was done. So was I!!!!!!

Now back on deck to organize some working bees. 44 cubic metres of screened soil is now on site, thanks to the MAAA grant. We will use our machines to work with Rob Addison and his excavator to fill in the bad low spots on the East and West Runways. We will then fill in cracks and small low spots by manual working bees.

For those who have been to our field recently you will have noticed the lush green grass runways. This is a great problem to have - the grass is now too thick and needs to be cut lower.

This great grass growth is due to the special mix that Daniel and I applied over the past few months. Next step is to spray for the African Beatle in early September. Hopefully this kills them before they eat our lush grass. Only time will tell.

Our new member **Rob Addison** did a fantastic job laying pipes, and back filling the open spoon drain beside our main carpark. He worked 6 days straight in very cold weather. Thanks also to Chris Caulcutt for helping on the first day. We will top dress it and spread some seed. Please thank Rob and Daniel when you see them for helping improve our field.
