EDITOR'S BIT

Flying Something else

I got this thing for nothing a while ago and thought I would see if I can get it together and fly it. It's called an FPV 168 or something like that, from HK (discontinued).

Found some small servos in my odd servos box and pushrods etc, plus an ESC, an E-Flite Power 25 motor (from Model Flight SA) plus a Spectrum receiver.

It didn't have a canopy and I had to spend a lot of time fabricating it from balsa strips etc.

Time to set the C of G and it is grossly tail heavy (it is a fiberglass body). Turns out it is designed to carry an old style, large camera, battery, transmitter up front plus a LiPo for flight.

To counter this, I used 650gm of lead and a 4S 5000 LiPo up front to get it to balanced pretty close.

Test flight #1. The nose wheel folds under and the rear wheels fold to the rear. Small wheels and heavy grass and it will not lift off so back to the workshop. Beefed up the undercarriage big time, added larger wheels and a more rigid strut setup.

Test flight #2. This time with improved up undercarriage. Flew it last Saturday and it flies ok, although a bit sensitive on the elevator. More Expo fixed that. It floats in on landing and it can fly surprising slow.


