PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Presidents Report February 2022

Welcome again everybody and I hope that you all had a great start to 2022. For the most parts, the weather has been kind and a lot of our members have been making the best of the holiday break to get out for some well-deserved aeromodelling.

As usual, a huge thanks to the mowing team for their efforts all the time and once again the field is in great shape.

Our first committee meeting for 2022 is now behind us and a couple of points worth noting. We are currently looking at some amendments within the club constitution as well as work on the proposed irrigation system. A few committee members will be meeting in the weeks ahead to start drafting the changes to put to the members. The Facility Manager (along with members of the Future Planning Group) will be looking at the best way to have the irrigation system installed to get the maximum benefit from it.

Daniel has lodged the merchandise orders so we are hoping that these will arrive in the next week or two.

Our membership has been on the rise each month as you will see in the registrar's report. Quite a few of those new members are turbine pilots which will mean even more action in our skies and lots of different airframes. It is great to see our facility being used with increased capacity and more pilots making use of our field.

As well as that, a few current members are making the progression to gold wings. The gold wings is very different to the bronze or silver and will require a much higher "pass" mark but it will make you a much better and more confident pilot. Don't be put off by the routines in the test, it is not tested to an aerobatic standard and your instructor will have to make decisions based on the type of model you are using. More important factors are how you coordinate the plane in flight through the manoeuvres and how consistent you are. The required procedures can be tested over four flights so you do not need to complete it in one session. The secret is don't rush, don't cramp yourself up (you have a lot of sky to make use of) and use your throttle accordingly. To help more members achieve this, we will be running some general flying instruction days in the very near future.

Also, a reminder to all operators of giant models that you need to be gold wings endorsed and require written permission of the club to operate your model at P&DARCS. This is not a club rule but included in the MAAA MOP 015 stipulation which is part of the model inspection. All you need do is send me an email with details on your model (with the permit) and the committee will quickly discuss the approval.

That's enough from me, over to the rest of the committee. Clear skies to all and I hope to see you at the field shortly.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

January 2022 Committee Meeting Summary

The Club's committee met on Thursday night January 20th 2022 via Zoom. Some of the items considered are noted below;

- VMAA Trophy will be held in 14 & 15th of May 2022 at our club field.. Club Captain looking for members for the team and helpers to run the event.
- Outdoor BBQ the current one needs to be replaced. Committee is investigating a replacement.
- Construction of the new irrigation system has been put on hold.
- 11 new member applications have been received in January.
- A risk assessment of our facility is being planned.
- The vehicle hoists are to be serviced.
- The Ferguson tractor is being serviced.
- The 2022 Club Calendar was reviewed and events scheduled. See the club web site for details.
- The Web Master advised that he has to "re-build" the Club web site due to software changes.
- The refurbishment of the front entrance has been on hold due to Covid and difficulty of obtaining the necessary material.
- It was agreed that due to the ever changing Covid restrictions the Monty Tyrrell will not have catering. Attendees to bring their own food.
- Discussion were held over the competency of some pilots with regards to the aircraft they were flying, in particular turbine powered aircraft. The Committee is continuing to evaluate this concern.
- Pilot Barrier will be removed as soon as a working bee can be organized.
- It was agreed that the Club Constitution needs to be reviewed. A sub-committee was formed to do the review and make recommendations to the Committee.
- The Committee agreed to review the current discounts for share purchase.
- An assets register of the club has been completed and revealed that it appeared we may be under insured. The Committee will address the matter. It was noted that this did not apply to our equipment/machinery assets which are covered by a separate policy.
