### **HEAVY MODEL PERMITS**

If you are flying a model weighing more than 7 kg, you **MUST** have that model and the pilot of that model certified by a Heavy Model Inspector. This applies to each model over 7kg AND each pilot

You must carry the Permit with you and have it available for inspection at any time at all MAAA affiliated venues

The Heavy Model Permit is **VERY IMPORTANT** for Insurance Cover. In the event that a uncertified Heavy Model, is involved in creating damage to persons or property MAAA Insurance will not cover P&DARCS or yourself

Do not be tempted to test fly a heavy model prior to it being certified, if it creates damage to persons or property **YOU WILL BE PERSONALLY LIABLE** 

The P&DARCS Committee members will now be policing this, so be prepared to show your permit. If you don't have it, you will be asked not to fly that model.

### LATEST ON OUR NEW SHED

Over the last few weekends, our small team of professionals have been quietly working on finishing our new shed

The finishing work carried out recently includes;

- Reinforcing the side pedestrian access door making it more robust, fitting security key locking, and a hold back hook and eye
- Fitting of four security cameras, one inside and three outside, including special mounting brackets
- Installing, and fitting out a security system cabined, including uninterruptible power supply, 4 camera Ethernet interface, and associated cabling and connections
- A Locking system for the Rolla' door, using a horizontal drop bolt arrangement, and security key padlocks
- A locking system for the three main sliding access doors, including security padlocks
- Physical barriers are also installed in front of both the Rolla' door and main sliding doors, in the form of Locked down robust bollards

### **MAAA Grant Application Result**

As reported earlier in the year, the MAAA announced a funding grant scheme for field improvements. As advised earlier we applied for a grant of \$13,834 for the purchase and installation of three vehicle hoists, the same units as the one we currently have in the old shed, plus transportation and installation costs.

The club was advised recently that our application was unsuccessful. Apparently our application was not considered as I forgot to include a copy of our audited financial statements.

To say that I am a little annoyed would be an understatement, particularly when the MAAA already had the documents they required as they were sent to them as part of our application for the loan for the shed, which we declined due to them requiring a mortgage on our field. I would have thought a phone call requesting the required documents would have been prudent, but then I was wrong.

I apologize to the club for my error in not completing the application correctly and hope that we do not get another flood before we have the funds to purchase the vehicle lifts.
