FIELD MANAGER

Hi guys, eventually back on deck and my 96 year old Dad is starting to call the Aged Care facility Home. We have sold his house and nearly finished clearing it out after he has lived there since 1955. Yes there was a fair bit to throw out because his generation has lived through the great



depression. Why did they call it " Great " and why did they call the first world war Great !!!!!!! Not my idea of Great.

As per my March Report, Daniel and I have sprayed the runways, pits and the 2 main carparks with the New Zealand Aerobatic Flyers recommended mix of Milk, Molasses and Humic Acid. We sprayed them on 26th May and 5th July. Results are amazing. Have never seen the grass so lush, especially in this non growing season

We have also filled in most of the cracks on all runways, except for the outer 3 metres. We have left these bad cracked areas as a trial to see how effective the Lime addition will be.

As per my report in March "I plan to have the lime spread on our runways in June/July when heavy rain scheduled. " The Lime application was done on Thursday 21st July and I apologize for the short notice to close the field for 3 days but the forecast was for light winds Thursday morning then 5 days of rain. Perfect for Lime application and the runways were still firm for the lime spreader truck. Hopefully this will be the last we see of bad cracking.

A few months ago we applied for a MAAA grant to improve our runways. The good news is the MAAA have given us a \$5,500 grant and have already paid for the Lime application. They only pay the contractors or suppliers, not us.

Next stage is to buy a few truck loads of screened soil (that I have used for the past year) and fill in remaining cracks prior to September, grass growing season. I will be calling for helpers for 2 or 3 working bees.

We will also spray poison to try and kill off the Black African Beatle. We will do this a few times and at present I am sourcing various poisons to determine most cost effective one. During September we will also spray the ingredient mix, milk / molasses / humic acid again to improve grass growth.

Let's keep our fingers crossed to see how effective the Beatle poison is. We then will see if our improved grass survives the summer, if not eaten by the beatles. If successful then we may not need to sow fine couch grass, but continue with the ingredient mix and the beetle poison. The runways have the best grass that I have seen, especially for the non-growing season.

Another project is Rob Addison will use his excavator to lay pipes in the large exposed drain beside our main carpark after the Lime spreading. Special thanks to Daniel for his great support and to Peter Harrison, Rob Addison, Steve Malcman, Norm Parker and Dave Glossop for helping fill in the cracks. Great team work guys.

Ivan Chiselett is getting ready for the big P&DARCS Scratch & Kit Built Scale Rally On November 5th and 6th

Ivan Chiselett is getting ready for the big P&DARCS **Scratch & Kit Built Scale Rally** as he recently test flew his new scratch built model B-25 Mitchell. It was built from Ziroli plans cut by **SC Models** and is 2,57M (101") span and has a mass of 13Kgs. It is powered by two Motorolfly 3625 Electric motors with 2 X 5000mah 5 cell batteries.

The electric motors give it plenty of power and the takeoff run was less than 30M. It flies very well with no vices. It has air operated retracts with sequencing gear doors to replicate the full size aircraft as well as a rotating upper turret with machinegun noise and landing lights.

The model is of the B-25 that was flown on Australia back in the late 1980's. It was sold to the US and now resides at a museum in Chino near LA. It now wears US markings. The tiger on the side was from the sponsorship the aircraft when it was in Australia by Esso, who at that time had a tiger as its logo. Remember the Esso advert of "put a tiger in your tank". The aircraft in Chino still has the tiger on its side, (see the photo inset of the Tiger)

The decals on the model were made using photos taken of the full size at Chino when Andrew Smallridge, Paul Sommerville and Ivan went to the US in 2011. The photos were scaled then printed and then soaked in water, placed face down on a sheet of glass and the paper carefully rubbed off the photo with a finger until there is just the thin film with the photo on it. It is then let dry, cut to shape and then stuck to the side of the model. All other decals were painted.
