EDITOR'S BIT

The Visit to Peninsula Flying Club went well, the weather was just great, and the tour was full of interesting aircraft and other items of aeronautical interest

My favorite was a large multi-cylinder radial engine, on display in Graham Hoskin's hanger, a monster of an engine, with two large supercharging blowers at the rear

This engine made use of, water injection, also known as **anti-detonant injection** (ADI), the intake system can spray water into the incoming air, or directly into the cylinders to cool certain parts of the induction system where "hot points" could produce premature ignition, or knocking

Water injection was used historically to increase the power output of military aviation engines for short durations, such as during dogfights or on take-off


At last weekend's meeting the question of ageing members not having insurance cover was raised. I put forward my view of the issue at the meeting and advised I would double check with MAAA.

My comments were correct as confirmed below by MAAA Secretary.

In summary. There is no age limit for Public Liability or D&O (club committee member cover) The only age limit is for the personal accident cover .

This is the income protection and lump sum cover offered to members. In the real world this cover is usually not available after age 60 or 65 so the 90 age limit on the MAAA policy is pretty good. This type of policy is in place to cover an incident where there is no liability so the public liability is ineffective. But there maybe a disability or loss of income as a result of the accident.

FIELD MANAGER'S REPORT

Hi Everyone,
I have nearly finished filling in the low spots on all runways, made by this year's cracks and previous year's cracks that were never levelled off. I have done it throughout June, prior to the grass growing season, while the low spots can be seen easily. You will see a huge improvement as the grass grows. Daniel has also sprayed the runways and pits for the broad leaf weeds. Thanks Daniel.
My next step is to kill off the coarse kikuyu couch on the runways and then begin to spray the nutrient mix plus liquid lime to the runways to improve the soil condition which will stimulate grass growth. Will do it again early spring plus spray for the black African Beetle.
In July we will get more soil delivered, (still part of the MAAA grant) to fill some of the large low spots at each end of the main runway plus the northern end of the East runway. We will also be working in the pits to fill the sunken area along the septic sewer line, plus low spots from cracks etc. The low areas on the runway ends and along the sewer line will be done by our machines, so not requiring a working bee.
