
CLUB MEETING TIME

Control Line Circle Update

Report by Mark Smith

The control Circle is now coming along nicely after a unforeseen delay causing the project to come to a stop. We are back at it again and have been busy cutting, levelling and rolling the site further. The final circle diameter has been marked out at 21 metres (69 feet) and the overall circle is 30 meters in radius.

The circle is now within 75mm of being flat overall.

The next stage will encompass the installation of the 3 metre concrete circle in the middle of the circle and the installation of the below ground level riser post and pipe into the concrete.

This will be completed at the same time the concrete is poured and could be used should a speed model be flown from the site in the future.

The post and riser is being manufactured to the FAI standards by one of our the club members

An area has been set aside for the growing of couch grass from cuttings and it will be planted in the spring in several 3 x 3 meter nursery areas.

The Couch has been grown off site over the last 12 months in foam tomato boxes and is ready to be planted into the nursery.

Over the next couple of weeks (weather permitting) the weed eradication process will commence using a selective herbicide.

The chosen summer grass for the area is Santa Anna couch.

The Santa Anna has been chosen because of its drought tolerance and ability to recover quickly.

An over sow of a winter grass will also take place on the circle itself. A winter grass has not yet been selected.

Top soil will now be bought in when available and stock piled off to the side of the circle and will not interfere with club operations or the circle itself.

Fertilizer as well as a straw base has already been purchased and will be installed when enough top soil is available.

If anyone knows where the club can obtain decent soil, please contact Mark Smith, Paul Somerville or Peter Harrison.

In the meantime, the circle is quiet usable for general sports flying.


