## VMAA TROPHY DAY AT THE STATE FIELD 12 – 13<sup>th</sup> APRIL

#### Greetings Members,

The VMAA Trophy event was held at the state flying field on April 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup>.

Our club team was made up of eight members with a few of us entering into more than one event, with enough to enter into all twelve events.

This year we had placings in most of the events which earned us an overall equal 2<sup>nd</sup> place.

Our resident helicopter pilot and committee member **Paul Webber** managed to secure 3<sup>rd</sup> placings in both helicopter events.

**Paul** was flying a smaller T-rex 600 helicopter and competed against larger 700 F3C machines and flew well despite the windy conditions.

I flew in the combat event surviving the event with only one streamer cut, really was not enough to cut it, quite literally.

I did make up for this by taking out a 1<sup>st</sup> place in thermal glider with a borrowed polish design glider from my father. Everyone was quite surprised how well it flew, including myself – considering it was the first time I had ever flown the model.

**Cliff McIver** took out 1<sup>st</sup> place in Fun Fly and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in Scale Aerobatics, with a junior competitor from another club taking out first place with his 1.5 bonus points.

**Roly Gaumann** experienced some technical difficulties with his Piaggio model in the first round of the Fun Scale event although he managed to make it through the second flight without any issue and made up for this in Sunday by doing really well in the Limbo event to take out an equal 1<sup>st</sup> place.

**Stephen Green** competed in the Club Pylon event with the RCM Expert model leant by **Cliff McIver** and managed to secure a comfortable 1<sup>st</sup> place, which added to our tally. Stephens father Brian entered the Electric Glider event to rekindle the Father Son duo.

**Kevin Fryer** went into full throttle and headed for the clouds with his "Cumulous" model in Old Timer event to take a 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

**Peter Harris** flew consistently well in the Musical Landings event to earn a 2<sup>nd</sup> place.

Well done to all our club members who donated their time to practice and compete and attend in the VMAA Trophy. I hope it has been just as rewarding for you as it has been for me to see P&DARCS rise up from an overall third place (last year) to a second.

I strongly encourage any P&DARCS members and in particular Juniors' of our club who may be interested in participating in the VMAA Trophy for next year to consider supporting your club as it is a fun weekend for all involved.


