- # IF YOU SEE LOCAL FARMER'S COWS ON EITHER WENN OR FOWLER ROADS, CALL THE LOCAL POLICE

HEAVY MODEL PERMITS

If you are flying a model weighing more than 7 kg, you **MUST** have that model and the pilot of that model certified by a Heavy Model Inspector. This applies to each model over 7kg AND each pilot

You must carry the Permit with you and have it available for inspection at any time at all MAAA affiliated venues

The Heavy Model Permit is **VERY IMPORTANT** for Insurance Cover. In the event that a uncertified Heavy Model, is involved in creating damage to persons or property MAAA Insurance will not cover P&DARCS or yourself

Do not be tempted to test fly a heavy model prior to it being certified, if it creates damage to persons or property **YOU WILL BE PERSONNALY LIABLE**

The P&DARCS Committee members will now be policing this, so be prepared to show your permit. If you don't have it, you will be asked not to fly that model.

P&DARCS Sub-Committee Membership Drive.

A motion was put to club members for voting at this club meeting(11th April)

Current share rules:

Anew member is a Probationary member for 1 year then Associate member for up to 2 years where the member is encouraged to buy shares. Associate Membership attracts a 50% levy until shares bought.

Motion: That the Committee has approved a new Membership initiative.

This initiative is at the discretion of the Committee and will be reviewed periodically.

Option 1 has been recommended by the subcommittee-.

A new or current probationary member may opt for either a or b:

a/ One year free membership if shares bought outright immediately after probationary year.

b/ pay share price over 10 years with a 10% share value supplement on annual membership fee

If the member leaves within the 10 years then his supplement is forfeited unless special leave is sought and approved by the committee.

Remain an associate Member for 10 years @ \$140 supplement/ year.

*Note that the Committee will need to amend the club constitution in order to enable option b

This entails legal and lodgment costs so the Committee will only do this if there is interest by members in this option.

NEW SHED WORK STATUS

Over the Easter break, the underground sub mains electrical cables were installed to supply power to the new shed from the Clubhouse main switchboard

Whilst digging the trench for the cables, we knew our trench would cross over the main power cable feeding our site from the street, this cable was located earlier, with a cable locator, and we were very careful not to disturb it, we were able to uncover it by hand to make sure we did not damage it with the excavator, all good
