Personally, I delivered one of my best competition flights yet, supported by flight coach data confirming the consistency of my known routines, with only minor slips noted across the weekend.

Winning nearly every known routine was a highlight, despite a setback in one double where I lagged behind my competitors for reasons I am not sure of. Nonetheless, earning another promotional point remains a thrilling achievement, even if I don't have immediate plans to use it.

Cam's victory was well-deserved, particularly considering his comeback from previous disappointments. I was let down by my performance in the unknown, with two critical brain farts and two missed snaps.

Competing in the Advanced class alongside seasoned pilots like Brian Stenbergn, Ash Carter, Andy McMillan, and Cam was a privilege. Their fantastic flying made my second place finish even more rewarding.

I extend special thanks to the Bundaberg Model Aero Club for their outstanding efforts in hosting the event, and to the ASAA for their ongoing support of our hobby's growth and vitality.

The camaraderie among competitors made the event not only enjoyable but also highly professional.

Brian Stenberg's superb efforts as CD showing his huge heart and passion for IMAC throughout the entire event, his passion is truly infectious.

Congratulations are due to all the competitors; given the challenging conditions, the calibre of flying across all classes was incredibly high.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH Veal Scallopini with Mushroom Sauce

I'm so lucky and truly grateful that my wife, Ruthie, is an outstanding cook (Chef !!). One of my favourite dishes she "creates" for our indulgent pleasure is her Veal Scallopini with Mushroom Sauce.

Please Note:

This same recipe can also be with Fettuccine Pasta, instead of the Veal. Either with the Veal Scallopini or the Fettuccine Pasta, the combination with the mushroom sauce is truly a Culinary Delight !!

Ingredients:

400gm Veal (sliced)
3x Shallots (thinly chopped)
½ Kilo Sliced White Mushrooms (medium size)
25gm Butter
Drizzle Extra Virgin Oil
200ml Bulla Crème Fraiche
1x Cup Apple Cider
Salt & Pepper to taste

Please Note:

Another option for the Veal, is a large piece of veal cooked like a "large steak", then cut into the thickness of slices to your liking. Then serve with the mushroom sauce.

Method:

Melt the butter & a good drizzle of extra virgin olive oil in flying pan Toss in sliced Shallots Toss in sliced Mushrooms until lightly brown Pour on ½ cup Apple Cider Stir until liquid is <u>ALMOST</u> evaporated Add Crème Fraiche Add salt & Pepper to taste Stir all together

In separate pan... Fry veal slices for 1 minute each side If Mushroom Sauce becomes "thicker", then heat up again until the sauce becomes liquid Pour Mushroom Sauce onto Veal
